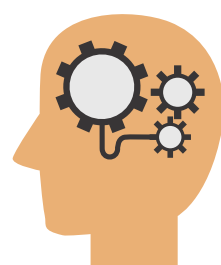
Home learning: Thursday 25th February



Literacy: blending with sound cards

Use the sound cards in your phonics packs to make words with a selection of the sounds. Follow the steps in the video to help children segment (spell out) and blend (read using 'Fred talk') simple words. Lay the cards out and ask them to choose the right sound or put the cards in order and ask them to read them.

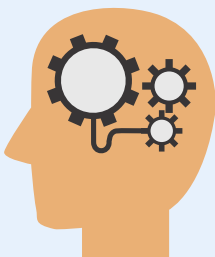
These cards are a great way to keep practising these fundamental reading skills at home.



Maths: number rhymes

Log into Maths with Parents to learn the "One More Bunny" song. Sing it along together. Share what you thought on Maths with Parents to get an up to date certificate!

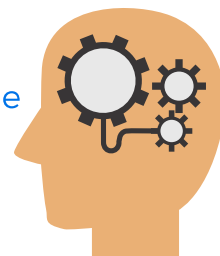
Songs help us to store information in our long-term memory, which is really helpful when we need to use our working memory for other things, like adding or subtracting.



Expressive art and design
