



WHAT WILL WE LEARN TODAY?

Home learning: Day 8



Literacy: toy talk









Maths: match numerals



Lay out different quantities of items in different arrangements - five pens, three cups, two keys and so on. Ask your child to match this week's number cards to the quantities. The easiest arrangement is to put items in a line. Make an irregular arrangement for extra challenge.

This activity helps children to practise counting regular and irregular arrangements of objects. It helps them to remember that numerals match to quantities and to remember what numerals look like.





Silhouette pictures



Can you draw around a shadow? Stand in front of some light or hold your hand up in front of it and place a piece of paper where the shadow falls. Can you draw around the edge of the shadow together?

Children learn to draw by beginning to understand that lines can enclose a space to give it shape. This activity helps them to create the outlines of different shapes. It also helps them to understand shadows and the way that light changes.
