Morning Activity (STEM/Investigations based):	Activity guidance:	What will we need?
Put on a Fairy Tale show	<p>Dress up as your favourite fairy tale characters and act out a fairy tale story. If you need help to choose a fairy tale, try the project we have set on MyOn or find lots of free audiobooks of children's stories on www.storynory.com. Listen to the story and retell it by acting it out.</p> <p>Listening to stories is one of the most important ways that young children learn. It develops their vocabulary, understanding and literacy. Afternoon Activity (Creative/Physical/Play/Exploration based):	Activity guidance:	What will we need?
King or queen for a day	<p>Many fairy tales have kings or queens as important characters and these people make the rules of their kingdom. Imagine you are in charge for a day: what are your rules and why? How are you going to encourage people to stick to them?</p> <p>Children are constantly learning about the rules of the world around them. Sometimes these are written down, like school rules, sometimes they are not. This is a good way to explore social rules.</p>	<p>Pen and paper if you want to write your rules down.</p>

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<p>Find out about fairy tales from around the world</p>	<p>Where do fairy tales come from? Can you find out about fairy tales from around the world? Are they the same or different? Many of our traditional tales are shared in Europe, with some interesting differences. Some places have very different traditional tales. Can you find out about stories from other cultures?</p> <p>Young children begin to understand that things are different in their home than they are in other places.
