**Key Stage: KS1 – Fairy tale day**

Morning Activity (STEM/Investigations based):	Activity guidance:	What will we need?
Build 3 structures based on The Three Little Pigs.  In the story of The three Little Pigs they each made a house and the wolf tried to blow them down. Your task is to create three different houses/structures and see which one is the best.	<ul> <li>Decide what your structures/houses are going to be made out of.</li> <li>Collect the materials you need and create your houses/structures.</li> <li>Decide how you are going to test your structures. The wolf huffed and puffed to blow the houses down. How can you create a 'wind' to test them?</li> <li>You could use a fan or wave something to create a breeze. How will you make sure the power of the wind is the same?</li> </ul>	Materials to build your houses/structures out of e.g.  • Lego • Paper • Cardboard • Plastic containers  Something to create the 'wind' • Fan • Waving a piece of paper or cushion
Afternoon Activity	Activity guidance:	What will we need?
(Creative/Physical/Play/Exploration based):		
Create a mask for a fairy tale character	<ul> <li>Decide on a character from a fairy tale.</li> <li>Choose a material to make your mask out of and make your mask.</li> <li>Think about how you are going to decorate it.</li> <li>What can you do to ensure people know what character you have chosen?</li> </ul>	Things to make a mask out of e.g.  Cardboard  Paper  Paper plates  Cups  Pipe cleaners  String  Coloured pens/pencils  paints

Put on a Fairy Tale show	<ul> <li>Dress up as your favourite fairy tale characters and act out a fairy tale story.</li> <li>Think about all of the different characters.</li> <li>Can you get other family members to join in with your story?</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Examples of fairy tales</li> <li>Use props and clothes around the house to dress up as different characters from the story you have chosen.</li> </ul>
Record yourself reading your favourite fairy tale	<ul> <li>Choose your favourite fairy tale</li> <li>Choose a space to read your story</li> <li>Read your story out loud and get someone to record you doing it.</li> <li>Think about how you can change the voices of the characters when reading aloud. Think about the punctuation and how it helps your reading.</li> <li>Remember to send a copy of your reading to us or take some photos of you reading your favourite fairy tale.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Favourite fairy tale – this could be found online or you may have a book that you enjoy reading.</li> <li>IPad to record yourself.</li> </ul>
