National Tell A Fairy Tale Day

Morning Activity (STEM/Investigations based)	Activity guidance:	What will we need?
<p>Design and Build Houses for the 3 Little Pigs.</p>	<p>This week for Screen Free Friday, we are celebrating <u>National Tell a Fairy Tale Story</u></p> <p>Therefore this week's activities are based around fairy tales.</p> <p>This morning, we would like you to investigate the strength of various materials. You are going to draw and build 3 different houses for each of the 3 little pigs- can you stop the big bad wolf?</p> <p>Step 1: Design your 3 different houses. Ensure you label your designs. Make it clear what each house is made of. Choose 3 different materials. Predict which</p> <p>Step 2: Build your 3 houses, using your designs for help. Have you got a figure to sit inside your house?</p> <p>Step 3: Test your houses for sturdiness. Have you got a fan or hair dryer? If not then maybe you can create a fan. Now direct the wind at each house at a time. What happens?</p> <p>Step 4: Evaluate your houses. Did they survive the wind? Create fairytale puppets and act your fairytale	<p>After writing your brilliant alternative endings, we now challenge you to create finger puppets and act out <u>your</u> fairy tale.</p> <p>Maybe you could record yourself (with the help of an adult) and send us your videos.</p> <p>Can you put on different voices for the different characters?</p>	<p>Paper/Card/Carboard</p> <p>Scissors</p> <p>Pens/Pencils</p> <p>Lollipop sticks or twigs (to hold the puppet)</p>
