To give everyone a chance to join in.


5 To help us show respect for each other.

To give everyone a chance to be heard.






Why do we need rules in our classroom?

We tidy up after ourselves.


We try our best.

We respect and care for each other.


We wear a face mask where possible..


We are mindful of guidelines in shops and other public areas.


