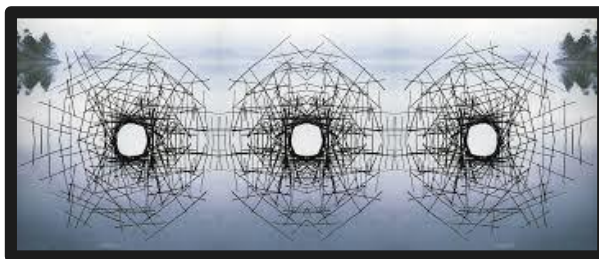
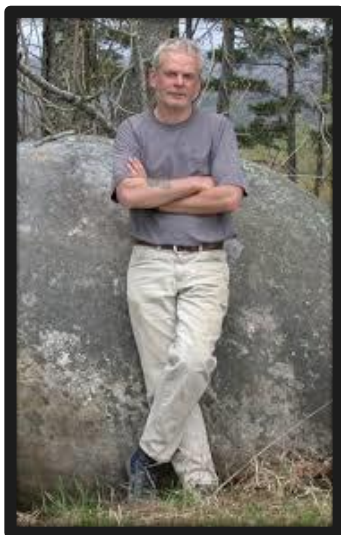
An example of how your research could look.

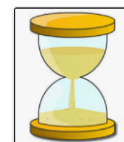
Andy Goldsworthy OBE is a British artist, known for sculpture and photography, using natural materials. He lives and works in Scotland.
