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## Using the word difference

## Anansi has nine carrots.

There are two cubes sticking out. Anansi has two fewer carrots than Turtle.

$$
\text { Turtle has } 11 \text { carrots. }
$$

Turtle has two more carrots than Anansi.
There is a difference of two between the number of carrots.
