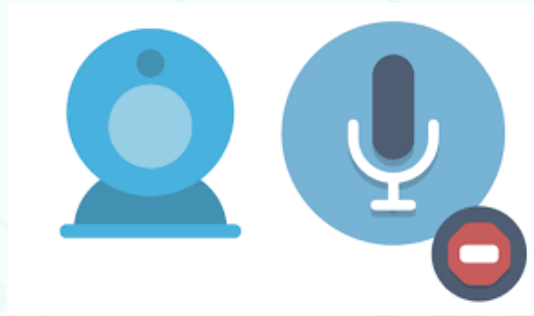

Putting Others First

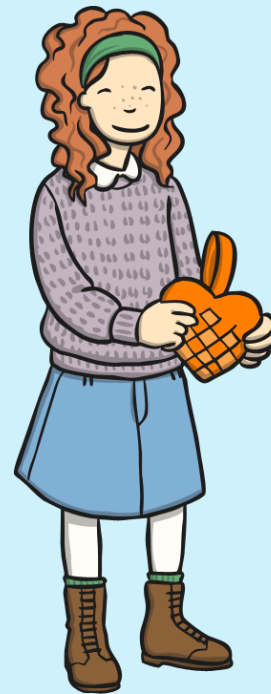
Have you ever given someone else your last sweet or chocolate, even though you really wanted to eat it?




How did Abu Talha put the poor man's needs before the needs of himself and his family?
