I know that it is ____ o'clock because the hour hand is pointing at the ____ and the minute hand is pointing at the ____ and the minute hand is pointing straight up.



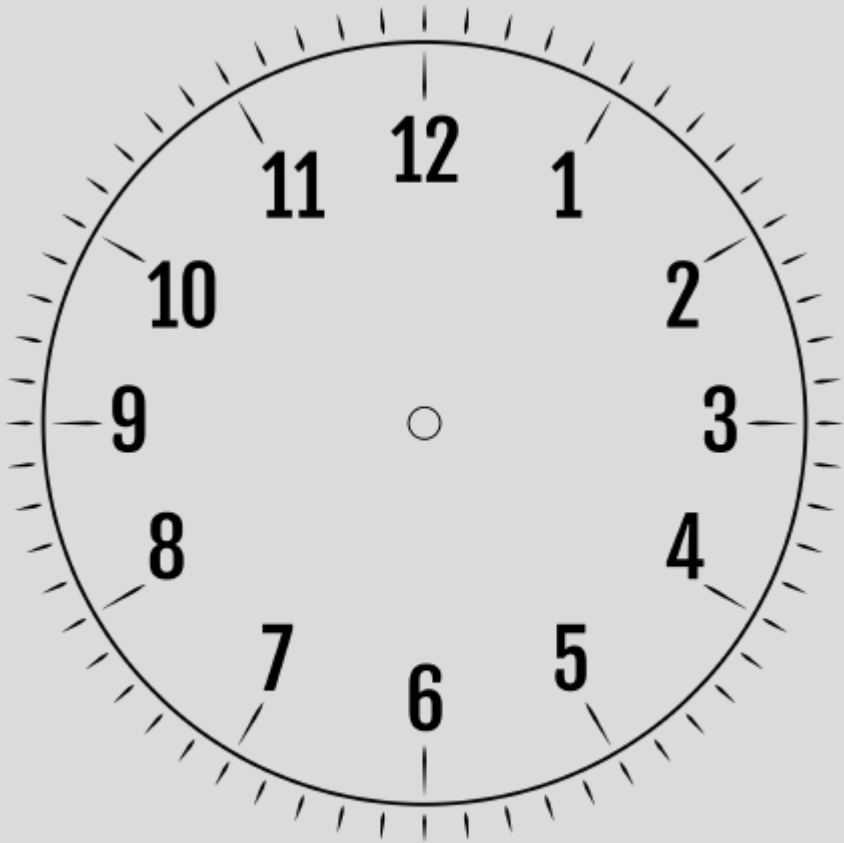
