

# Sorting Words




Can you spot what is different about these words and sort them into two groups?

### Sorting Words



Did you spot that some words start with the prefix un-?



How does adding un- change the meaning of these words?



tie kind

happy zip

unzip untie

unhappy unkind

### Sorting Words



When un- is added to adjectives (describing words) it means 'not'.

A prefix is a letter or group of letters added to the beginning of a word which changes its meaning.



kind — unkind (not kind)






happy — unhappy (not happy)








When un- is added to **verbs** (action words) it means the reverse of that action.


What do we get if we add un- to this word?

- b. unfit








Answer:
