Star Jumps

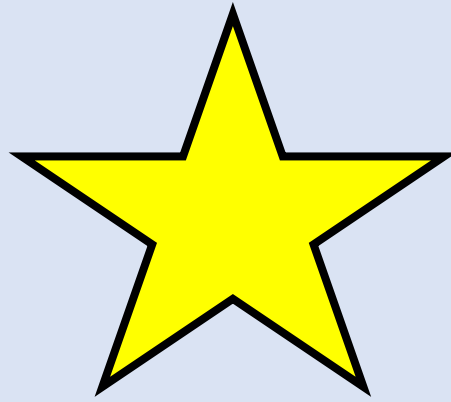
1. Start with your feet close together.
