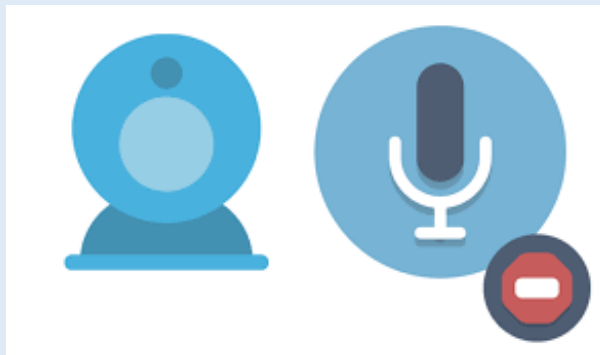

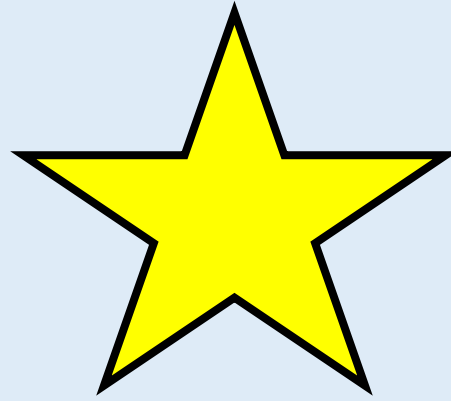

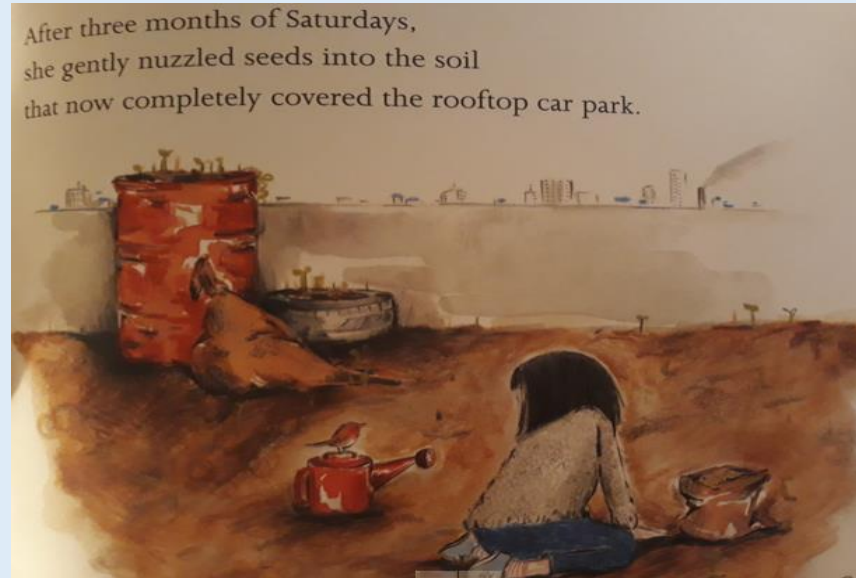
Each Saturday Funni lugged up a huge sack of soil, cleaned the carpet of litter, swept the drift of squished cans and other left-behinds.



After three months of Saturdays, she gently nuzzled seeds into the soil that now completely covered the rooftop car park.

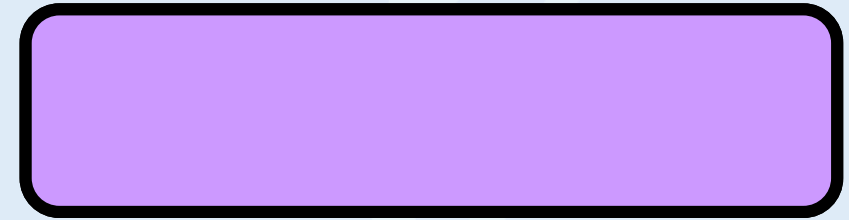


## I will know how to explore a character's feelings



This illustration is different to the others that we have seen in the book so far because this is the first time that we haven't seen Funni's face or expression. Looking at someone's facial expression can help us to tell how they are feeling.

- How do you think Funni might be feeling?
- What do you think her facial expression would look like?



If you have a mirror you could make the facial expression you think Funni would have on her face at this point in the story and have a look at it.

As Funni's facial expression can't be seen in the illustration we can't tell how she is feeling. I have had a think about how I think that Funni might be feeling at this point of the story. I have drawn a picture of Funni to show her facial expression.

How do you think I think Funni might be feeling? Explain your thinking.

Your task is to draw a picture of Funni showing how you think she might be feeling at this point in the story. Make sure that your picture shows Funni's facial expression. When you have finished drawing your picture of Funni, write a sentence to explain how you think she might be feeling and why.
