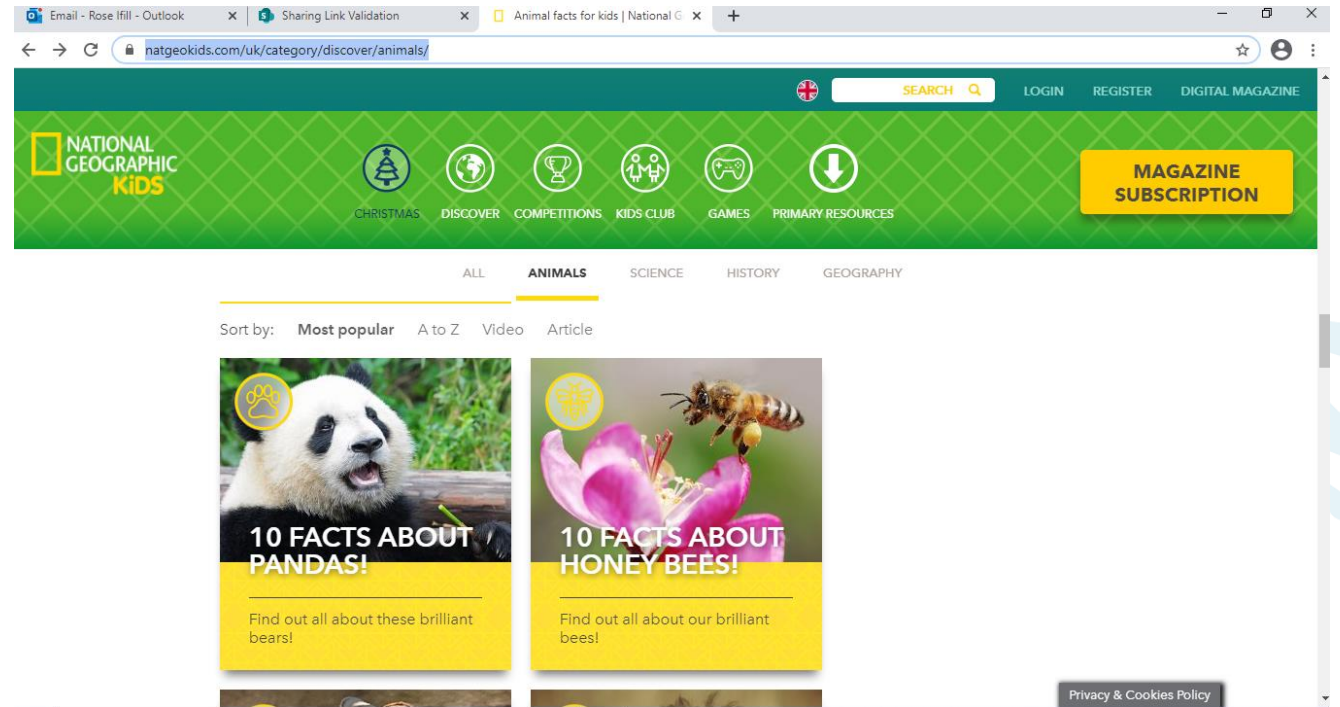




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Practice it: click on the link on your worksheet which will take you to National Geographic Kids, there are a selection of different fact files on this page for many different animals.
