 5. Harry checks to see if the God's are looking, they shake their heads but Harry ignores them.




 Harry has the clay in the shape of a snake and he is urging it to slither and hiss. Ben and Sue are telling Harry to try again.

4. The children back away, Harry grabs Ben and Sue to protect them but then the snake sees a crack in the floor and slithers into it.


5. Harry and the others gasp and say "goodness gracious, what a thing". Harry stands quietly with his friends until Ben says "Perhaps we've made enough for today."













<u>I do</u>

Re-write the opening as Harry.

From plan:

Harry has the clay in the shape of a snake and he is urging it to slither and hiss. Ben and Sue are telling Harry to try again.

For example:

After Ben and Sue had created their creatures they turned to me and insisted that I also make a creature. I felt determined to make a creature just as they had, so I grabbed some clay and moulded it into the shape of a snake. I wanted it to become a real creature so I urged it to hiss and slither. I hissed impatiently at the clay as Ben and Sue kept telling me to try harder to make the animal come to life.
