I will know how to use verb tenses.

I do:

- Use 'was' when you're writing about a single person - 'I was, he was, she was'.
- Use 'were' for more than one person and for direct address - 'We were, they were, you were'.

For example:

I was so happy when I won that award.

They were so happy when they won their award.
