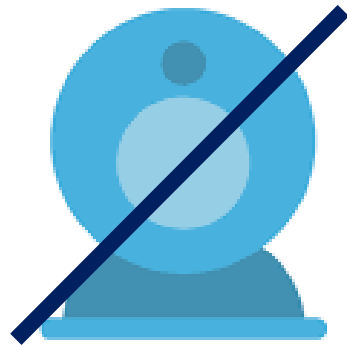

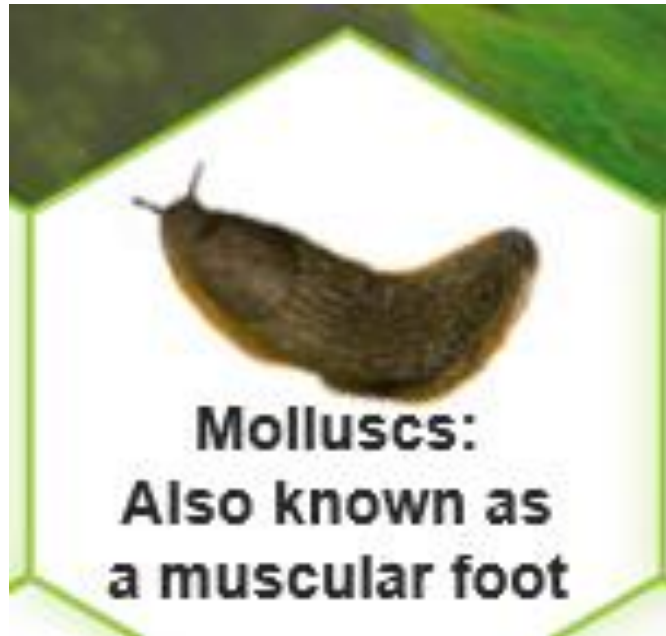


Are these all insects?

Each insect is classified into a certain class!



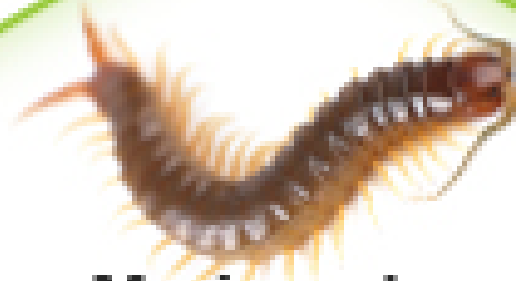

numerous legs**



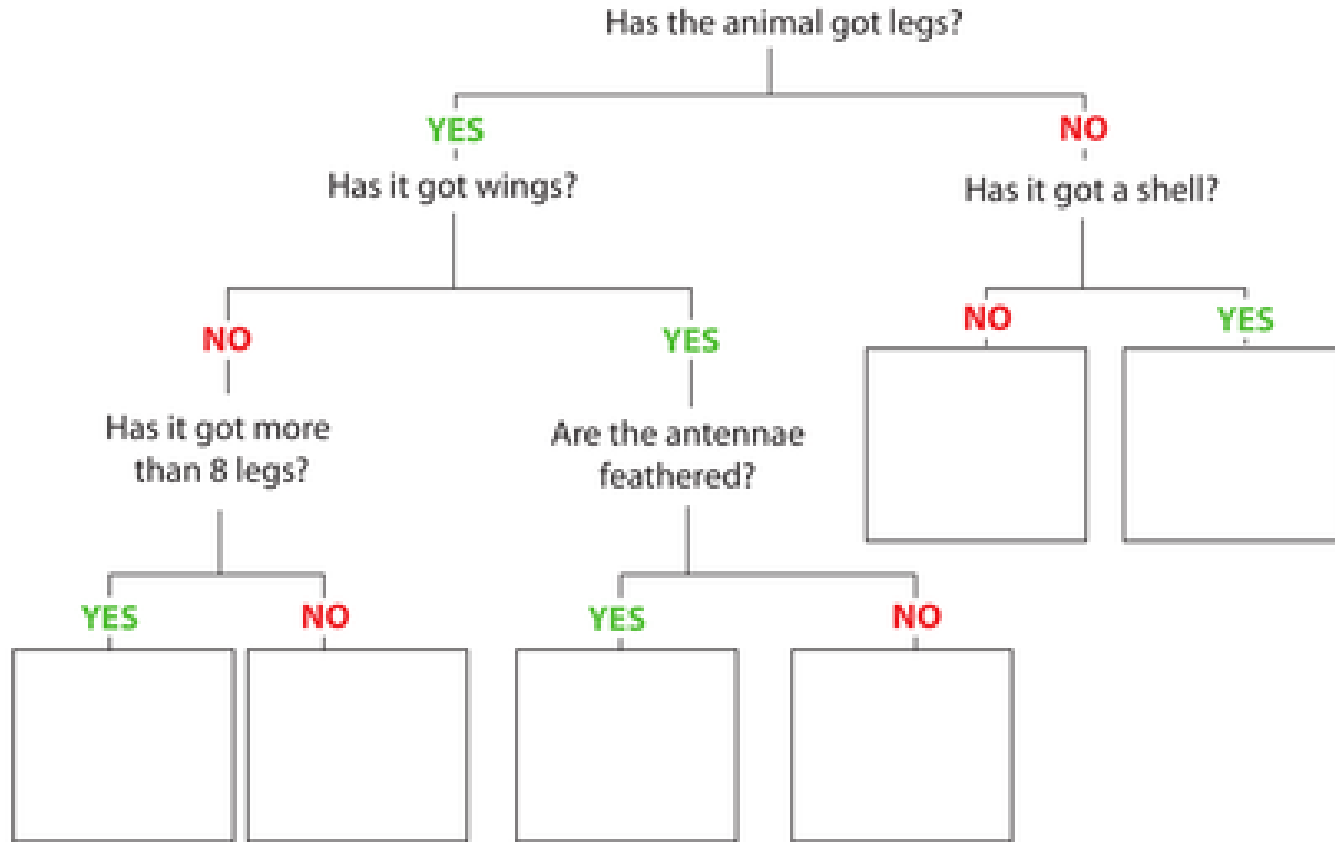
**Annelids
