



Persuasive letter: a written form of communication between two people; sent by one to encourage the other to do something / feel something / act in a particular way. (Heavily used in the past when one person / country needed help from another!)





Today, you are going to be writing a letter to Magpie from Dog, persuading her to NOT leave with Fox.




Is this persuasive? Not really.

Plenary: Persuasive letters

Persuasive letters - tick or fix:

- Emotive language creates an emotional response in the reader
- Imperative verbs are words such as stop, need, must
- Evidence means take information from the story to support your work
