

#### What are the features of persuasive writing?

Alliteration – Alliteration is what happens when two or more words begin with the same sound.

Come and marvel at the Amazing African Animal exhibit.

Repetition – Repetition is when a specific word or phrase is used multiple time throughout a text.

Buy this new phone now! Buy it today!

Imperative verbs – Imperative verbs are commanding words and are used to tell someone to do something.

Hurry before they're all sold out!

Opinions — Opinions are what you think or believe.

I think chocolate should be banned

Facts — Facts are pieces of information that have been proven true or are known.

Running five miles will make you fitter and healthier.

**Emotive language – Emotive language is words used to create an emotional response from the reader.** 

Gaze upon the majestic blue ocean and feel delighted that you chose this wonderous resort

Rhetorical questions – Questions that you are asking the reader but do not expect them to answer.

How would you feel if you lived your life trapped in a cage?
