



The hedgehog has got stuck in the glass jar. He won't be able to move and find food! He is extremely hungry.



- B) When you try to persuade someone you tell them what to do.




I will know how to make persuasive points

I will know how to make persuasive points

Persuade someone to think about why they shouldn't litter.

Miss Perkins' example

Firstly, you should do something about littering because litter because litter can make a place look unclean and untidy.

Secondly, you should do something about littering because animals such as hedgehogs might get stuck in a piece of litter.

Finally, you should do something about littering because people could step on rubbish and hurt themselves.
