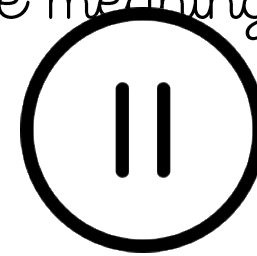

Synonyms

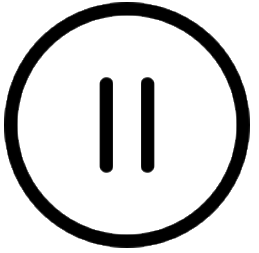
Synonyms are words that have a similar/the same meaning as another word.

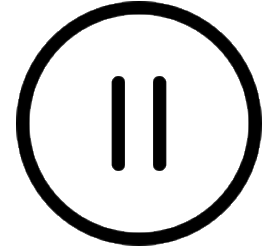

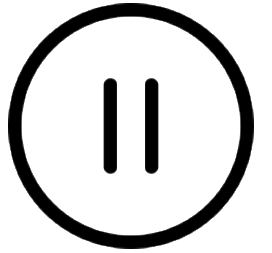

An antonym for hot would be cold.

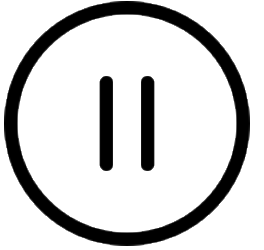
An antonym for evil would be kind.
