

Ordnance survey maps are very detailed and can help you to find your way.








How to Use a Grid Reference

We look at the bottom left hand corner of the square.

When giving a four-figure grid reference you use the **Eastings numbers first** followed by the Northings numbers.

An easy way to remember is to think 'along the corridor and up the stairs'.





Map symbols: why do we have symbols instead of words?

These symbols are used on Ordnance Survey maps to indicate specific features.

The maps are very detailed and so there isn't enough room to write down every feature in words so symbols are used instead.

To help the map reader to understand what the symbols actually mean, there is a **key** on the map.




