



I will know how to derive facts from known multiplication facts

Choose a calculation and write as many related facts for it as you can, write the calculations underneath it.  
The first one has some examples to get you started.

$$3 \times 4 = 12$$

$$12 \div 3 = 4$$

$$30 \times 4 = 120$$

$$8 \times 3 = 24$$

$$30 \div 10 = 3$$

$$27 \div 3 = 9$$
