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## Welcome to Term 2

### Term 1

### Reading books

### English

This term in English we will be continuing to develop our use of capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. Our lessons will be focused on a book called *The Way Back Home* by Oliver Jeffers.

### Maths

This term in Maths we will be looking at adding and subtracting numbers to 10 as well as looking at identifying simple 2D shapes.

### Trips and activities

This year we have organised a trip to the pantomime for the whole school and Year 1 will also be visiting Rochester castle and the Guildhall Museum in Term 3.
