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Welcome to Term 2


Welcome to another term and what a fun and busy one it will be. Last term the children worked extremely hard in all lessons learning the routines and the way they should be setting out their books.

Curriculum

PE

English

Maths

Last term the children focused on place value. We started using a number of resources which are helping the children develop their addition

and subtraction skills. This term we continue to look at addition, subtraction then move onto money, multiplication and division.

History

This term we are starting our learning on the Victorians, looking at Queen Victoria and the Railways.

Science

We will be looking at our planet, global warming and the importance of recycling and renewable energy.

Reading

Reading is still one of our main focuses and children are still receiving phonics lessons whilst others are now using their skills to understand and complete reading comprehension tasks. To support this, children should read with an adult every night and we will be submitting phonics homework each week to complete, this will be via Showbie or paper based.
