Reading books and Phonic screening



Reading at home is still an important part of children's development and we will continue to provide a range of books to enhance and improve reading across year 1. In June, the children will have to complete the National Phonic Screening assessment and we will be providing resources and meetings for you, so that you can help support your child in achieving the expected standard in this.

English

This term in English, we will be looking at George and the Dragon as our class text and we will continue to work on our letter formation, punctuation, and independence in writing.

Maths

This term in Maths, we will be developing our knowledge of addition and subtraction of numbers up to 20 and recognise numbers up to 50.
