Curriculum

PE

English

Maths

Last term we started our Money topic which we will be continuing. Children will learn the different coins and how to use them to make a certain amount. After, we will be moving onto multiplication. By the end of Year 2 children should know their 2, 5 and 10 times tables so we

will be adding in mini tables test each week to support them with this.

History

This term we are continuing our learning on the Victorians, focusing on Queen Victoria and what life was like.

Science

Our topic is 'Materials' and we will be looking at their properties. They will learn what flexible, reflective, opaque and translucent mean in order to classify objects and their uses.

Reading

Reading is still one of our main focuses and children are receiving phonics lessons as well as comprehension skills. To support this, children should read with an adult every night and we will be submitting phonics homework each week to complete, this will be via Showbie or paper based.
