Attendance



1. We at Oasis academy skinner street are committed to improve your child's

attendance. Studies have shown that in order for your child to reach their full potential, both academically and socially, regular attendance at school is essential.

Oasis academy will monitor your child's attendance. In the event that your child incurs 10 sessions of unauthorised absence in a six school week period a referral will be made to AASSA and a penalty notice will be issued to each parent/carer. You will receive a **£60** fine increasing to **£120** if not paid within 21 days. Failure to pay the fine will result in court prosecution for your child's non-school attendance.

We sincerely hope that you will work with us to continue to improve your child's attendance in order that they achieve their academic potential and enhance their future prospects. If you would like to discuss this further please do not hesitate to contact me Miss Allen, Attendance Officer.

2. If your child is going to be absent from school, on the first day of absence please email: attendance@oasiskinnerstreet.org

3. If you would like to request any leave during term time, which includes exceptional circumstances, religious ceremonies etc, you will need to complete a request of leave form which can be found on the school website <https://www.oasisacademyskinnerstreet.org/academy-life/attendance> which you are able to print at home and send into school, or if you would like a copy please email attendance@oasiskinnerstreet.org I am happy to send a copy home with your child. This form will need to be completed and a reply of the decision will be sent home shortly afterwards. (Please add the link jen)

4. When pupils arrive late, they can miss out on essential instructions given out at the beginning of the lesson, this can significantly reduce achievement, regardless of academic ability. Your child may also feel awkward arriving into the classroom late. When one pupil arrives late it disrupts whole class and the teacher -everyone's education is compromised.

Children need to be in school for registration between 8.40am – 8.50am.

Any children that arrive after this time will be asked to enter through the Skinner Street entrance. I will be at the gate every day registering the children that arrive late. If the children are Late on a regular basis this may incur a penalty notice being issued which will be £60 per parent increasing to £120 if not paid within 21 days.

We appreciate this is a lot of information given out at this time, and understand the different circumstances families have, we are happy to work with you, please do not hesitate to contact me if you would like further support.

For safeguarding reasons, if you have arranged for someone to collect your child, you must also inform the office. If we do not have confirmation of another person collecting your child, we will not release your child from site.

Medical

It is very important that you inform us of any medical needs/ conditions your child has. If your child suffers from asthma, we must always have an inhaler on site with the school asthma card signed by the parent. You can do this by requesting a new one from your GP and inform them it is for the school. To fill out an asthma school card, please contact the office.



We can only administer prescribed medications only. We cannot administer Calpol etc. unless prescribed by your GP.

School Dinners

Our academy meals are catered by Sodexo, and should be paid for via the school app MCAS (My Child at School). They cost **£2.25** per day. Please visit our website to view the menu.

Alternatively children may bring a packed lunch. We ask parents and carers providing

packed lunches to choose healthy options with a balanced selection of food including fruit and vegetables, juice and/or water. We do not permit sweets in packed lunches

KS1



We are so proud of the children, who have come back to school happy and eager to learn showing exemplary behaviour, what a wonderful start to the year!

In Key Stage 1 this term, our topic is 'Who am I, who am I becoming?'. This is a personal development focused topic in which the children will explore their hopes and goals for the upcoming year. In History, we will be exploring local history starting with our school community, this will support our learning in Geography where we will be learning about the local area.

Each child will require their iPad in school every day to participate fully in each lesson. If there are any issues with iPads please speak to your child's class teacher.

A quick reminder of PE days where children will be required to come in wearing their school PE kits.

KS2



Across Key Stage 2 our Theme for the term is titled **Who am I and Who am I Becoming**. In Maths the children are focusing on Number which includes place value, addition and subtraction. In Year 6 they will also be focusing on Multiplication and Division.

In writing, Year 3 are focusing on the book, *Jemmy Button*. Year 4 will be focusing on *Charlie and the Chocolate Factory*, while Year 5 will be focusing on the book *The Boy at the Back of the Class*. Year 6 will be focusing on the book, *The Boy in the Girl's Bathroom*. In addition, all years across Key Stage 2 will be developing their poetry writing.

In Science the various year groups are focusing on the following topics
Year 3 Skelton and Muscles; Year 4 Digestion and Teeth; Year 5 Living Things; Year 6 Circulatory System

In Geography lessons the children will be studying Human and Physical Features as well as learning about Oasis Schools across the world. In History the focus will be on each child's family history as well as their own.

In Computing, the children will be studying E-Safety and Coding, while in music lessons the focus will be on body percussion.

Year 5 are going Swimming this term. Willow Class will attend in Term 1, followed by Palm Class in Term 2. A separate letter will be sent to the Year 5 parents with further details.

Year 4, will be starting Challenger troop this term every Friday.

An MCAS account is set up for all parents which provides you with secure online access to view your child's data, including attendance, school reports and pay for dinner money/school trips etc. It is accessible 24 hours a day via PC, laptop and mobile devices with internet connection. It will give you live information and is specifically designed to improve the quality and accessibility of information for parents.


