

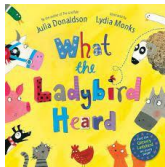
# Newsletter



## Welcome to Term 4

In term 4 our topic is Minibeasts and their habitats. We will be learning what a minibeast is and where they live. We will also be creating our own minibeast homes using a range of materials.

In literacy our story is 'What the ladybird heard'. We will be creating our own story maps and using our phonic knowledge to write words and sentences about the animals in the story. We will also be exploring adjectives as we develop our vocabulary to describe the animals.



In maths we are exploring numbers to 10, counting accurately to 10 and recalling different ways to make 10.
